0-5 MIT Units = 0 Harvard Credits

6-8 MIT Units = 2 Harvard Credits

9-21 MIT Units = 4 Harvard Credits

Students may not receive more than 8 Harvard credits in total for their MIT ROTC courses.

^^ MIT ROTC staff may require or allow Harvard students to take MIT 15.305 (a regular, non-ROTC MIT course) instead of AS.301/MS.302/NS.21.

This benefits Harvard ROTC students because 15.305 is not subject to the 8-credit cap that applies to their AS/MS/NS ROTC courses.

Harvard ROTC students taking MIT 15.305 must enroll in MIT 15.305 through my.harvard and meet all cross-registration deadlines and requirements.
